CEMETERY RULES

- 1. The cemetery is closed from dusk to dawn.
- 2. Alcohol, drugs, explosives or firearms (with the exception of military services) are prohibited.
- 3. Funeral floral arrangements shall be removed within two weeks after the burial unless the family desires to undertake task earlier.
- 4. Live holiday grave blankets, wreaths etc. will be removed February 1st unless the family desires to undertake this task earlier.
- 5. Silk flowers, decorations consisting of glass, ceramic, wood, cloths, etc. shall be maintained by the family and must be at either end or directly in front of headstone. The cemetery reserves the right to remove said flowers or decorations if they become unsightly or interfere with maintenance.
- 6. No animals are allowed in the cemetery.

ITEMS PERMITTED

- Headstones, monuments or markers
- Flowerpots, urns or flowers must be at either end or directly in front of headstone so as not to interfere with mowing
- Grave blankets
- Lot cornerstones must be at ground level <u>ITEMS NOT PERMITTED:</u> Anything that will prohibit mowing the gravesite (bricks, curbing, coping or ground cover stones, trees or shrubbery, etc) unless approved by board of directors.

This cemetery is owned and maintained by the New Gretna Old Home Society. These rules are made to promote safety, to improve the general appearance of the cemetery, and to make it easier to maintain. Your cooperation in complying with them will preserve the safety, beauty and dignity of our cemetery. Your patience, understanding and cooperation are anticipated and appreciated.
